Look for these Animals at Seven Falls



- No rock climbing or scrambling anywhere in the canyon.
- Stay on all marked trails and walkways.
- Wading in the creek is prohibited.
- Trail closes one hour before closing or at dusk in the summer.
- The rainbow trout have been stocked in the pools. Fish food is available near the gift shops to feed them.
